Speaker Mounting

Toss those mismatched drywall screws aside like yesterday's news and get ready for some deluxe speaker mounting options that will make you feel like a fancy-pants audiophile.

Mounting Option 1

- 1. Position and secure the template in desired location.
- 2. Carefully mark the 8 mounting hole locations.
- 3. Remove the template and drill 1/8" pilot holes in each location.
- 4. When it's time to mount your speaker, use a 4mm Hex and the ST5 x 25mm wood screws to secure.




ST5 x 25mm Wood Screws



Mounting Option 2

- 1. Position and secure the template in desired location.
- 2. Carefully mark the 8 mounting hole locations.
- 3. Remove the template and drill 1/4" through holes in each location.
- 4. Using a 3/8" drill bit, counterbore each hole 1/64". This is to allow the tapping insert to sit flush with surface.



- 5. Using a 5mm Hex, install a tapping insert in each location.
- 6. When it's time to mount your speaker, use a 4mm Hex and the M5 x 25mm machine screws to secure.
